The Commission has reached a final decision not to refer your case. The file on your case has now been closed.

We wrote to you on 12 December 2005 letting you know the Commission's provisional view of your application for review of conviction, and giving you until 16 January 2006 to make any further submissions to us.


We have now considered the further submissions that you made to us on 29 December 2005 and 12 January 2006 and have decided that there are no grounds to refer your conviction/sentence for a fresh appeal.
